Special program report organized for slow and advanced learners:

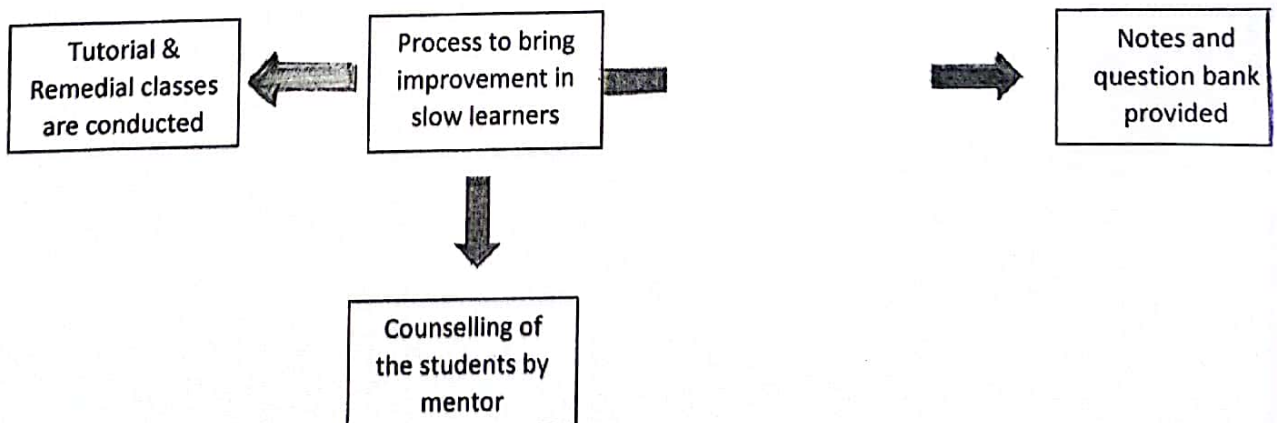

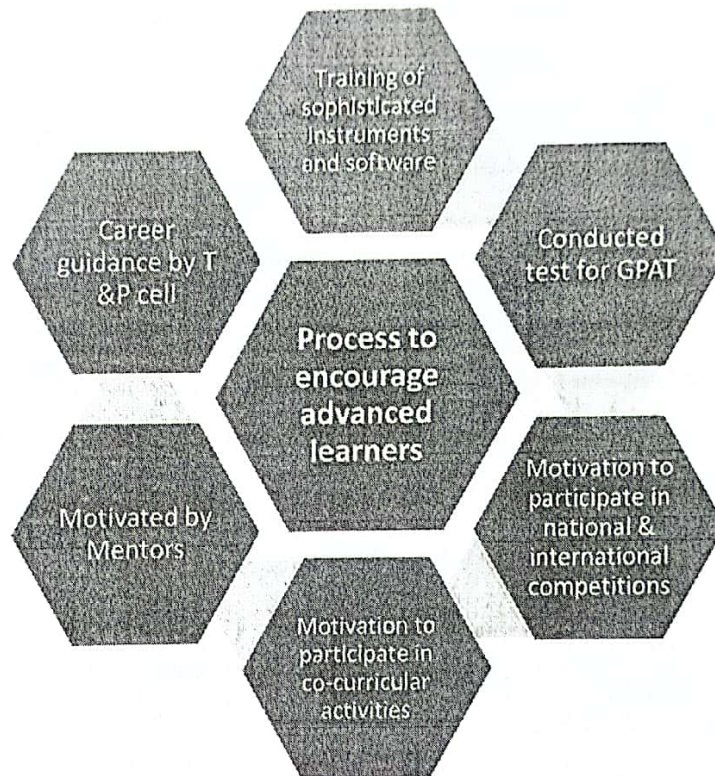
The college responds to the learning needs of the slow learners through:

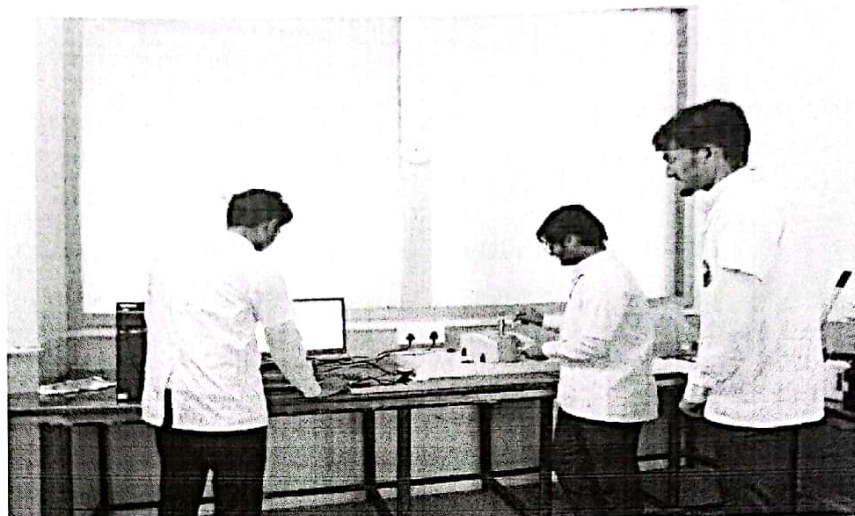

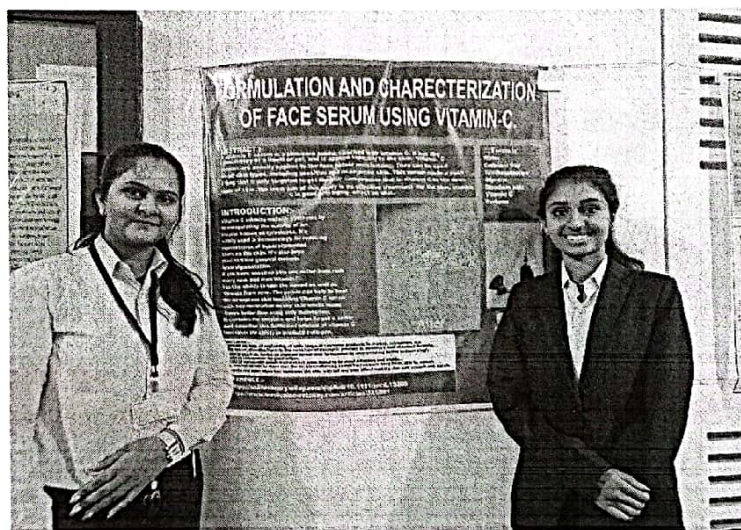
