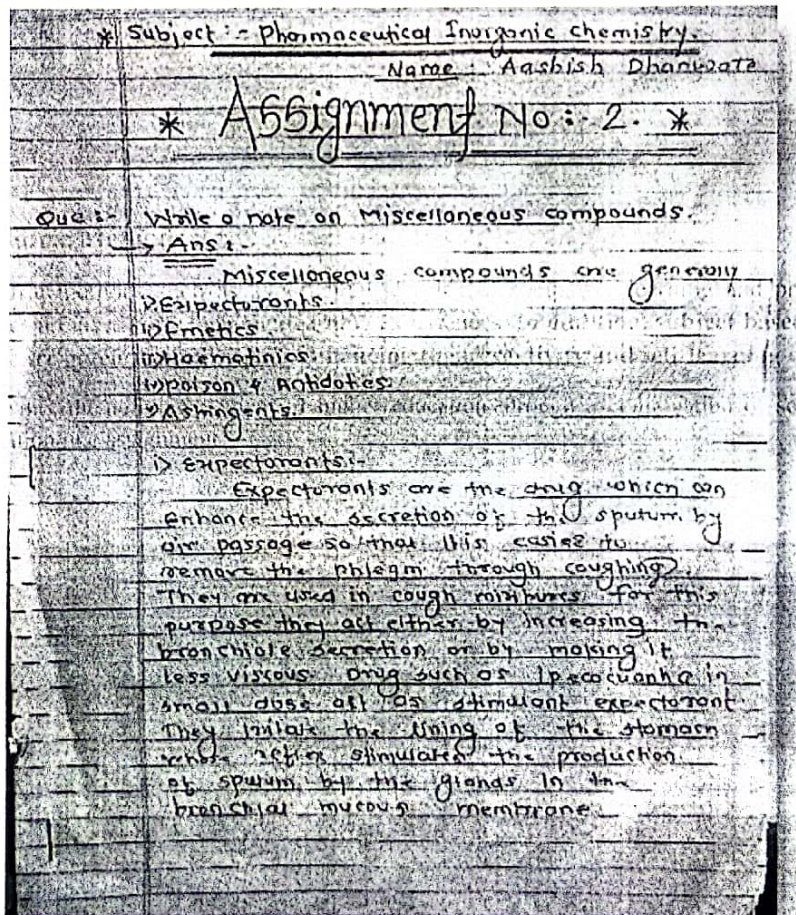

- Potassium iodide stimulates the gastric mucosa and increase the bronchial secretion. Ammonium chloride act like a potassium iodide but is less potent. Antimony potassium tetroxide also used as expectorant.

### a) Emetics:-

It is the involuntary forceful expulsion of the contents of one's stomach through the mouth and sometimes the nose.

An emetic such as syrup of ipecac is a substance that induces vomiting when administered orally or by injection.

- In emetics - used medicine that induces when a substance has been ingested and must be expelled from the body immediately (for this reason most toxic and easily digestible products such as rat poison contain emetics). Inducing vomiting can remove the substance before it is absorbed into body.

- Ipecacacuse can cause detrimental health effect.

- Salt water and mustard water have been used since ancient times as emetics. care must be taken with salt, excessive intake can potentially be harmful. copper sulfate was also used in past as emetic. It is now considered too toxic for this use. Hydrogen peroxide it is used as an emetic in the veterinary practices.

→ copper sulphate.

→ sodium potassium tetroxide.

### b) Haematinics:-

A haematinic is a nutrient required for the formation of blood cells in process of haematopoiesis.

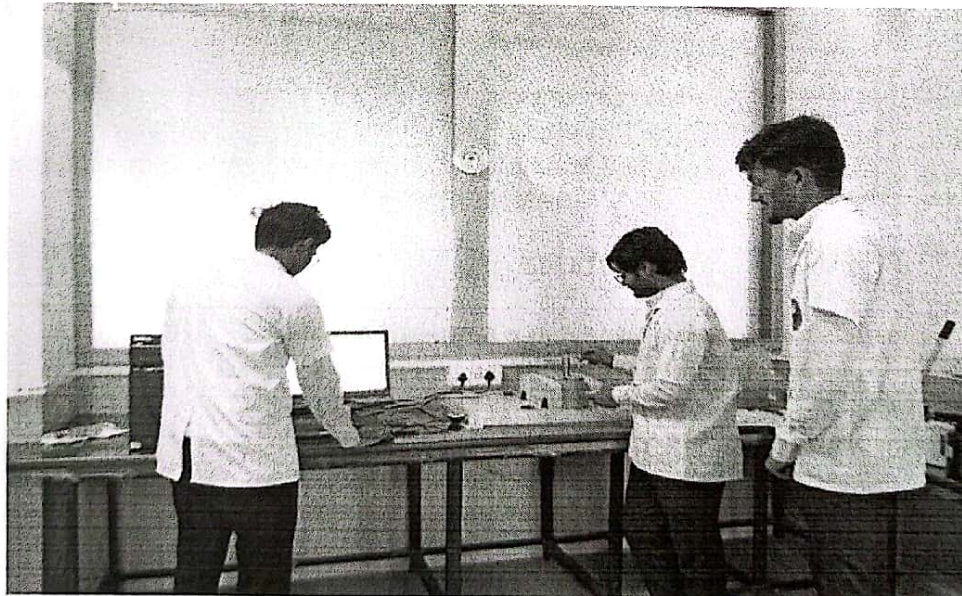
